

## April 2016 Bond Project Update

- BMCC Bond Project Manager Rob Dreier of Frew Development gave an update on bond projects at the April 6, 2016, BMCC Board of Education meeting. Drawings for the Workforce Training Center in Boardman were submitted to the City of Boardman in March, and documents went out to bid for construction on April 4. The Board approved a Memorandum of Agreement with the Port of Morrow for the land, which was needed before construction can start. A groundbreaking ceremony for the Workforce Training Center will take place May 25 at 2 p.m. in Boardman.
- Wellens-Farwell Construction out of Enterprise was selected as the contractor for the Precision Irrigated Agriculture Center in Hermiston with the lowest bid. The Board approved an InterGovernmental Agreement with Oregon State University for the land the center will be on at the OSU Experiment Station, also needed before construction can begin. A groundbreaking ceremony for the Precision Irrigated Ag Center will take place on April 27 at 2 p.m.
- Rob Dreier met with the Pendleton Fire Marshal to discuss firefighting solutions while the campus has low water flow. The Pendleton Fire Department was alerted that BMCC has low water flow and the department will subsequently bring its water tender to any fire response at the College until the water flow issues have been resolved.
